Your income details

DUO uses the income of debtors to calculate their ability to pay. As a result, the amount of your monthly repayment may be lowered, but never increased.

The parental income is used to calculate the student's supplementary grant.

Note to 1, 2 en 3

The details of the student/debtor, the taxpayer and their spouse/partner must always be filled in fully.

The taxpayer is either the debtor or the student's parent. If the parents are divorced, both parents must fill in and sign this form separately.

Note to 3

If the spouse/partner of the taxpayer signs the authorization, the local tax authorities are permitted to provide their financial data.

Note to 2.5 en 3.5

Does the taxpayer and their spouse/partner live on Curaçao or in Caribbean Netherlands (Bonaire, Saba, St Eustatius)? In that case, they will only have to send this form once. After that, DUO will request their incomes from the local tax authorities.

Does the taxpayer and their spouse/partner live on St Maarten or Aruba? Then they have to inform DUO of their incomes themselves each year, using the Income tax Statement form.

Note to 4

Fill in rounded amounts and in local currency.

- 'No tax return form was issued' applies if the local tax authorities did not issue a tax return form, but there is income information on the wage tax table included.
- 'Tax return was filed but not yet processed' applies if the local tax authorities did issue a tax return form but has not yet determined the wage tax.
- 'An income tax assessment was imposed' is applicable if the local tax authorities have made the assessment.
